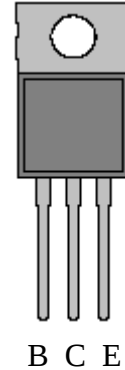

Silicon NPN Transistor
Final RF Power Output

Description:

The 2SC1306 is a silicon NPN transistor in a TO220 type case designed for use in high power output amplifier stages such as citizen band communications equipment.
