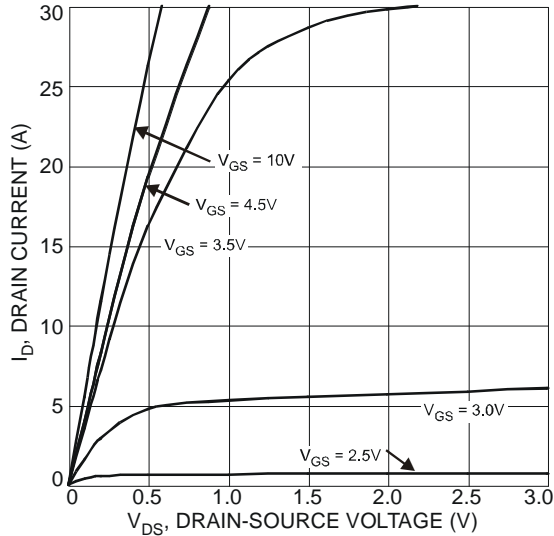


Fig. 1 Typical Output Characteristic

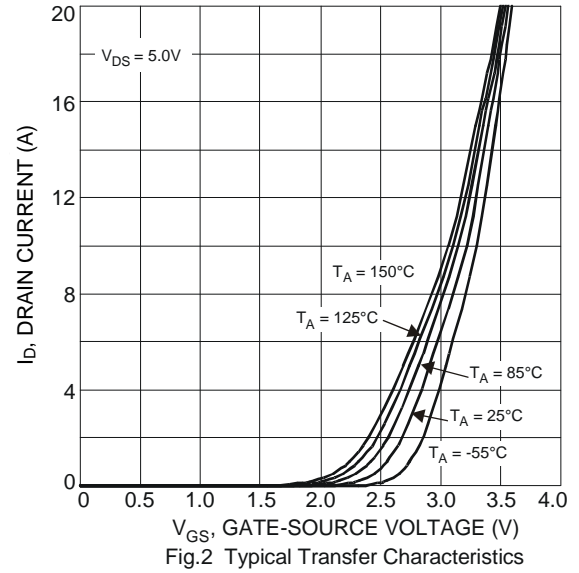


Fig. 2 Typical Transfer Characteristics

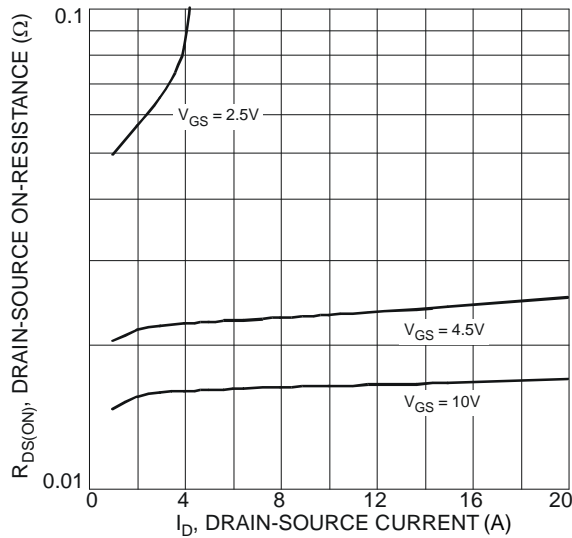


Fig. 3 Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

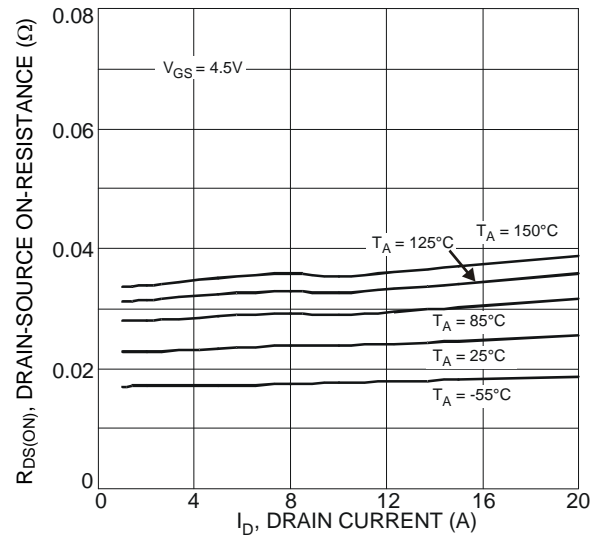


Fig. 4 Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Temperature

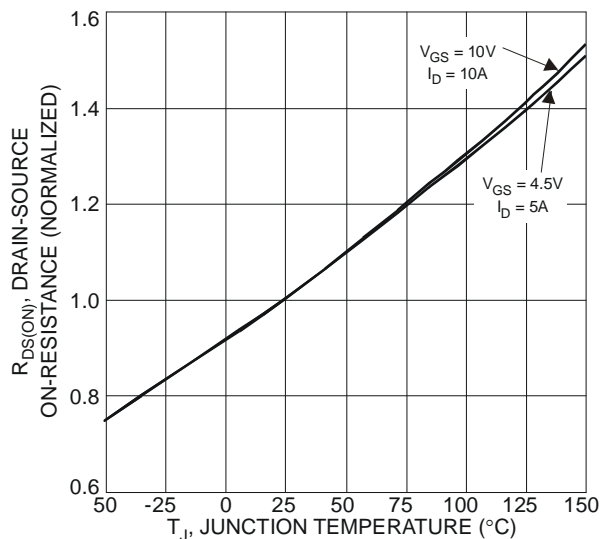


Fig. 5 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

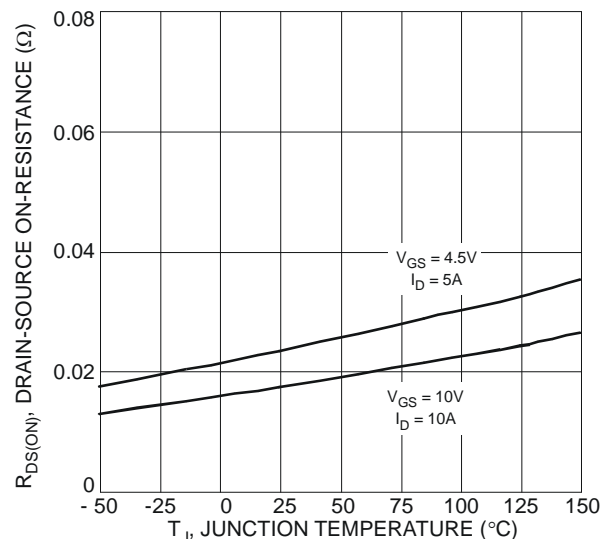


Fig. 6 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

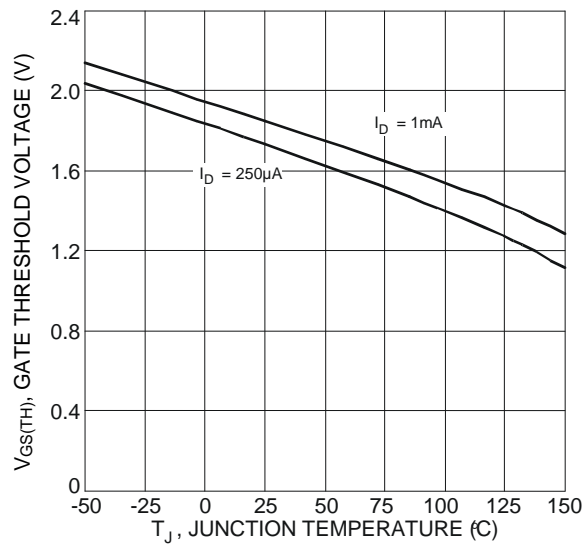


Fig. 7 Gate Threshold Variation vs. Junction Temperature

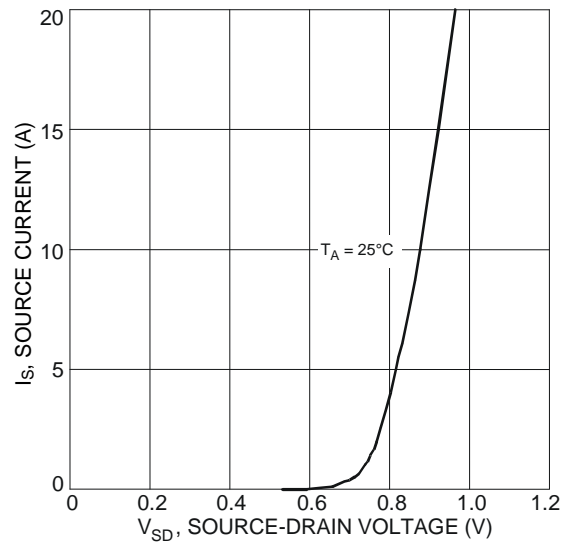


Fig. 8 Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current

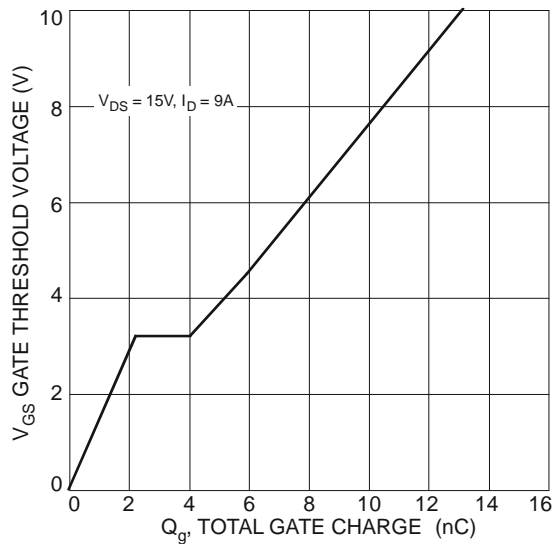


Fig. 9 Gate Charge

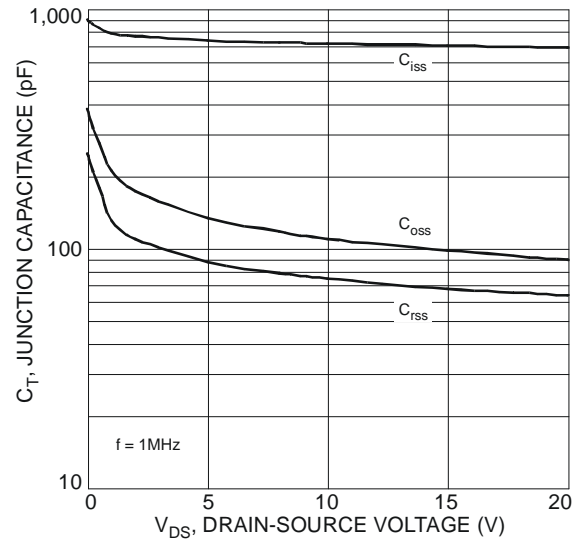


Fig. 10 Typical Junction Capacitance

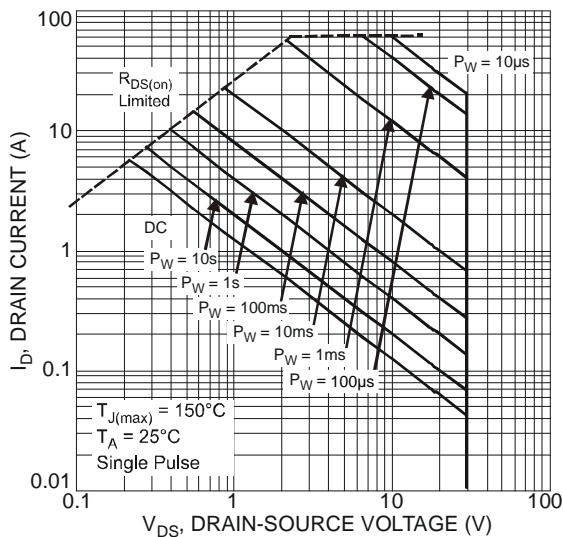
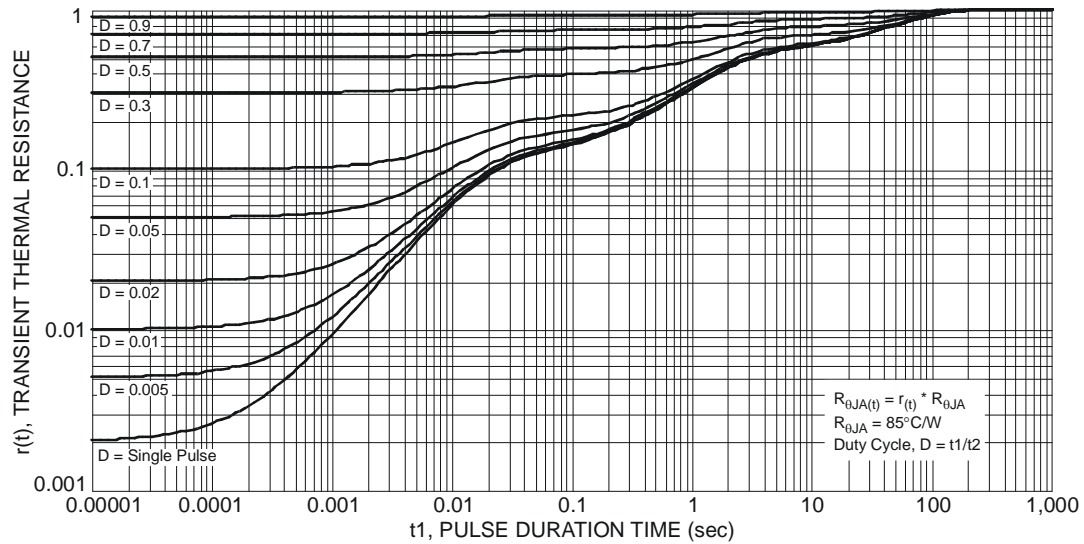
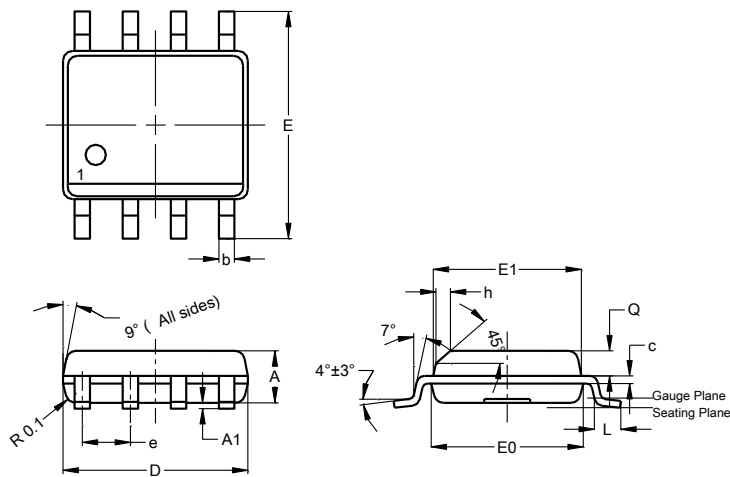


Fig. 11 SOA, Safe Operation Area

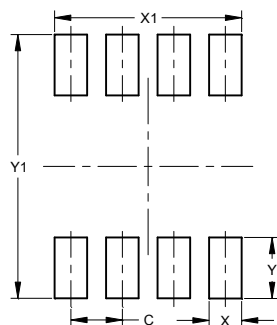
