FEATURES

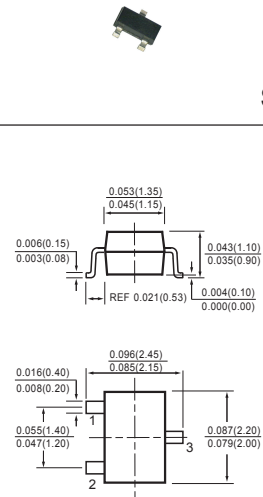
- * Built-in bias resistors enable the configuration of an inverter circuit without connecting external input resistors.

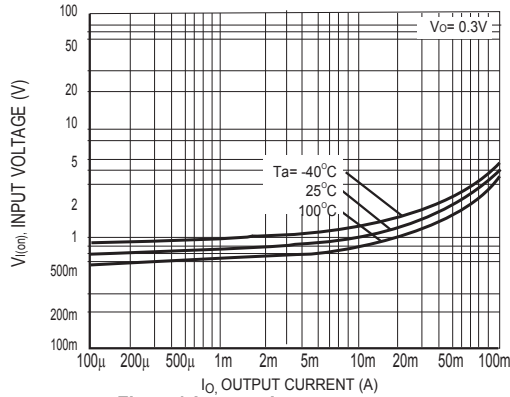

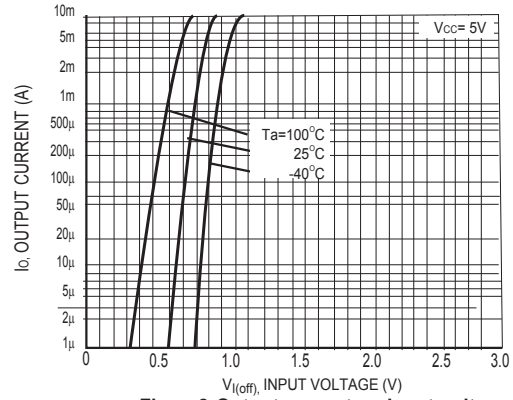

(OFF Characteristics)**

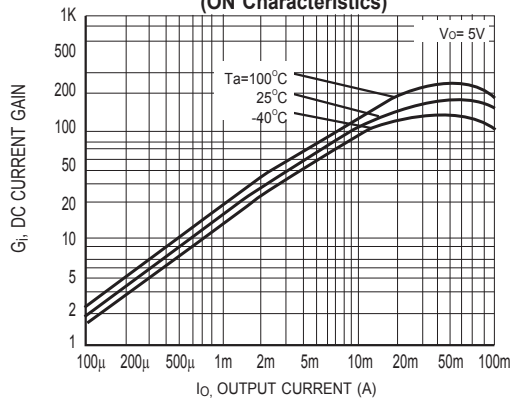


Figure3 DC current gain vs. output current

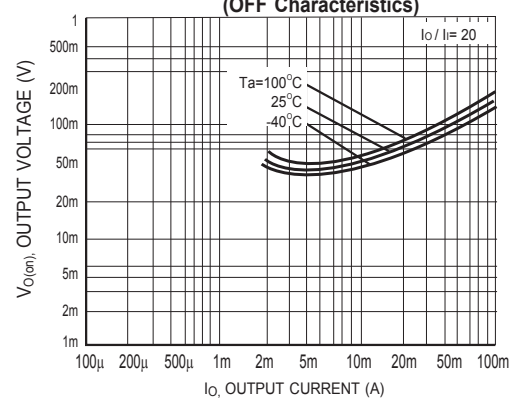


Figure4 Output voltage vs. output current

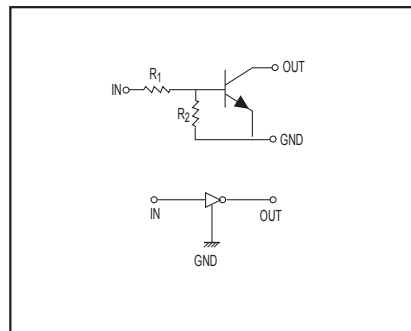


Figure5 Equivalent circuit

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
