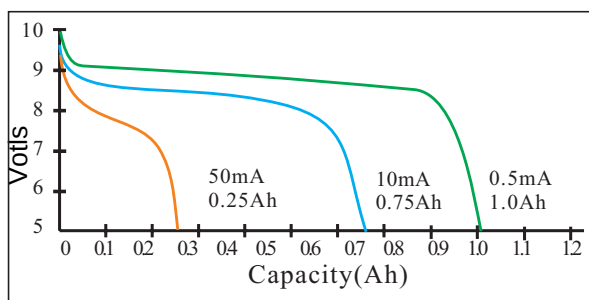

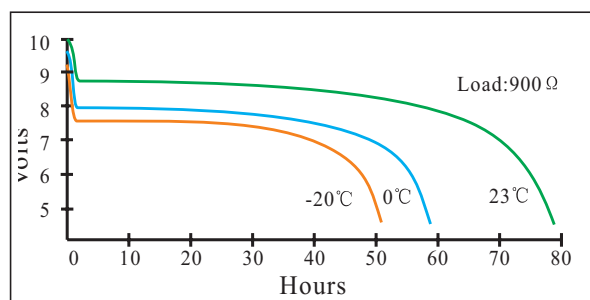

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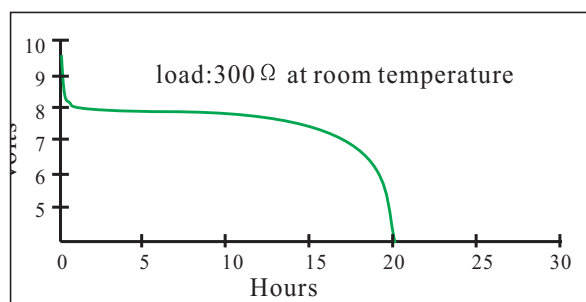
Typical discharge at 25°C



Typical Continuous Discharge



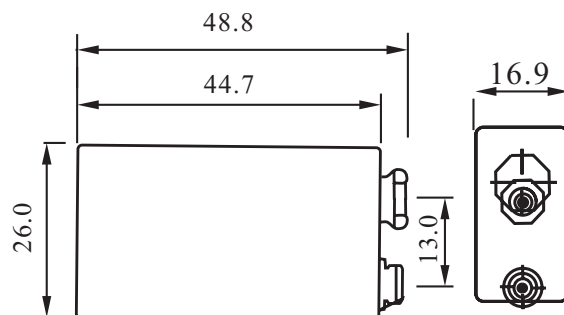
Typical Continuous Discharge
