




**Figure 1. On Region Characteristics**




**Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics**




**Figure 3. On Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage**



**Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature**




**Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics**




**Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics**




**Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs Temperature**




**Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs Temperature**

Fig 12. Gate Charge Test Circuit &amp; Waveform




Fig 13. Resistive Switching Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms




Fig 14. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms






Fig 15. Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit &amp; Waveforms
