


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Quadrant Definitions for a Triac

With in-phase signals (using standard AC lines) quadrants I and III are used.



Figure 2. Typical Gate Trigger Voltage versus Junction Temperature







Figure 3. Typical Latching Current versus Junction Temperature

Figure 4. Typical Holding Current versus Junction Temperature






Figure 5. Typical RMS Current Derating

Figure 6. On-State Power Dissipation




Figure 7. Typical On-State Characteristics






Figure 8. Typical Thermal Response
