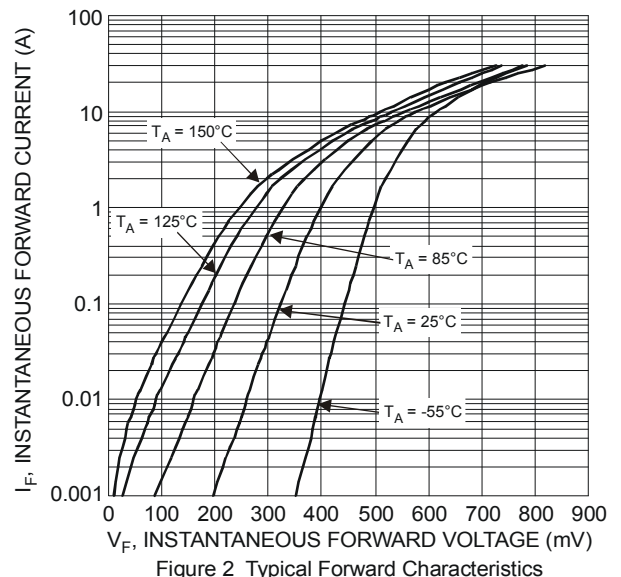
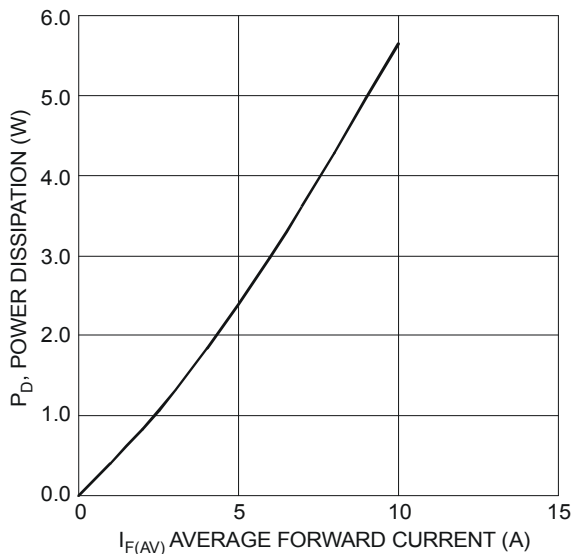

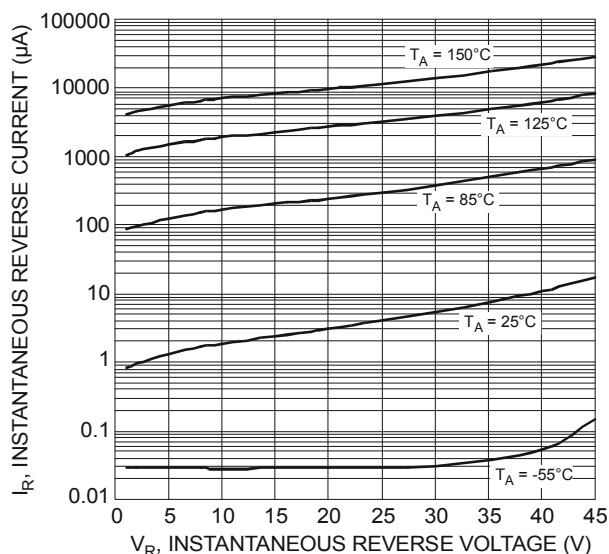


Figure 3 Typical Reverse Characteristics

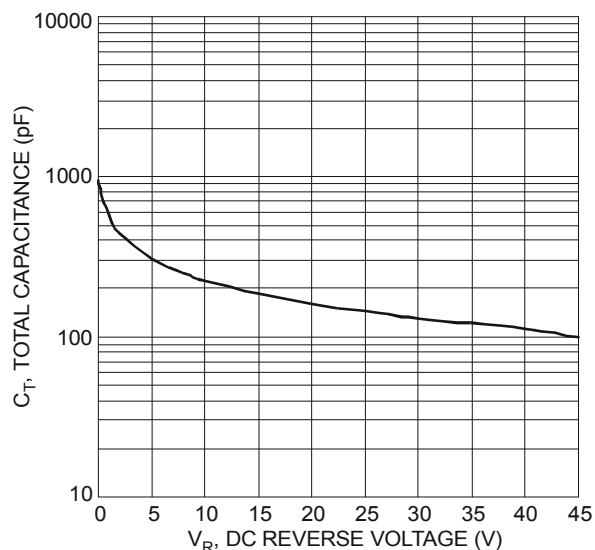


Figure 4 Total Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage

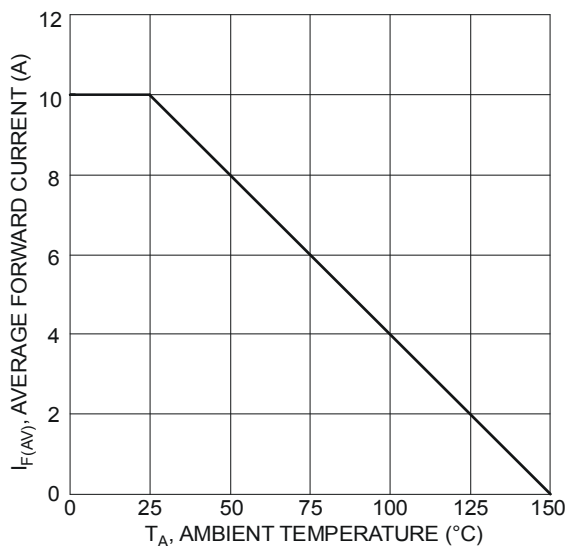


Figure 5 Forward Current Derating Curve

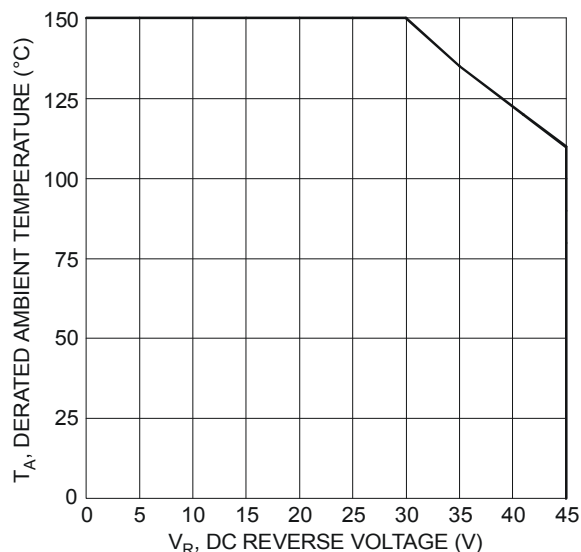
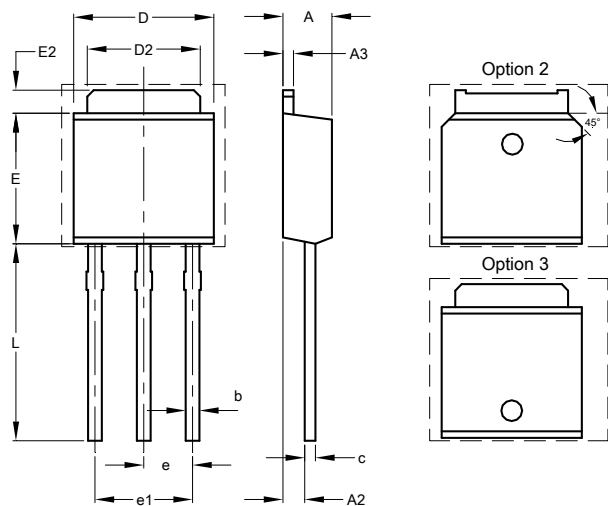


Figure 6 Operating Temperature Derating
