


Figure 1. Pinout (Top View)




Figure 2. Logic Symbol





Figure 3. Switching Waveforms

Figure 4. Test Circuit





Figure 5. Typical Input Threshold,  $V_{T^+}$ ,  $V_{T^-}$  versus Power Supply Voltage

Figure 6. Typical Schmitt-Trigger Applications






