

r(t) = thermal impedance under given conditions,

Pf = forward power dissipation, and

Pr = reverse power dissipation

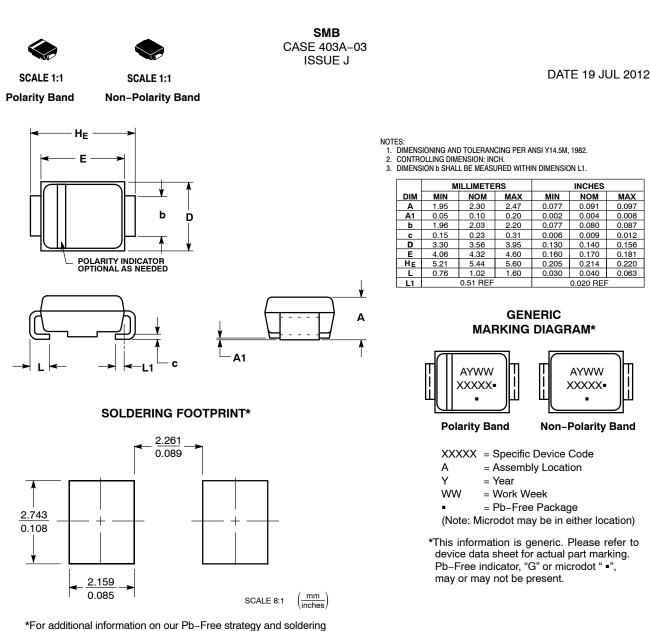




MECHANICAL CASE OUTLINE PACKAGE DIMENSIONS
