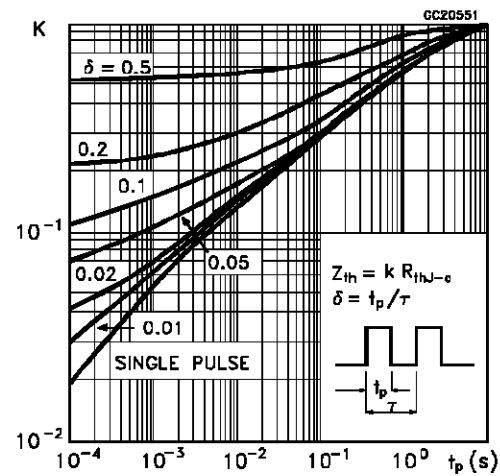

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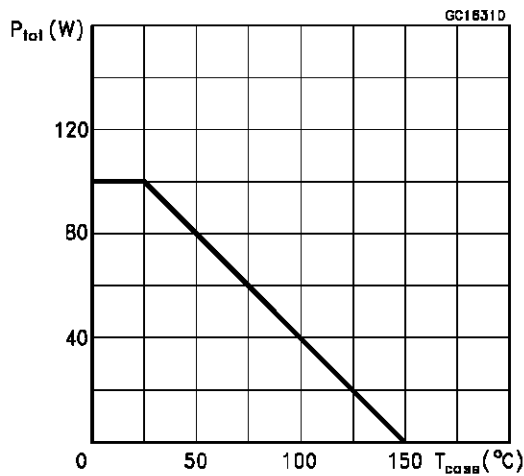
Thermal Impedance For TO-220



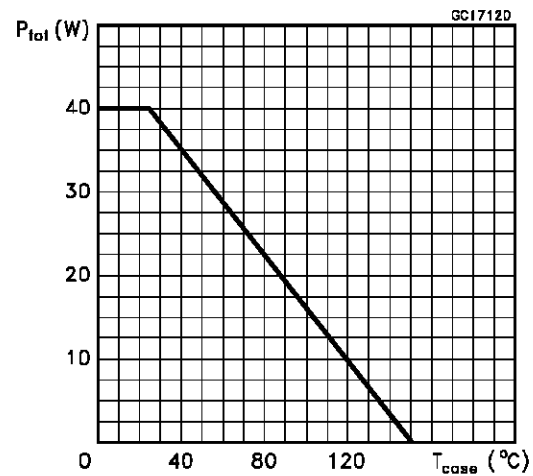
Thermal Impedance For ISOWATT220



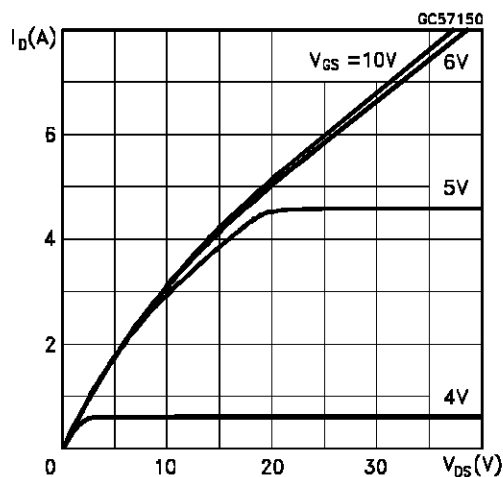
Derating Curve For TO-220



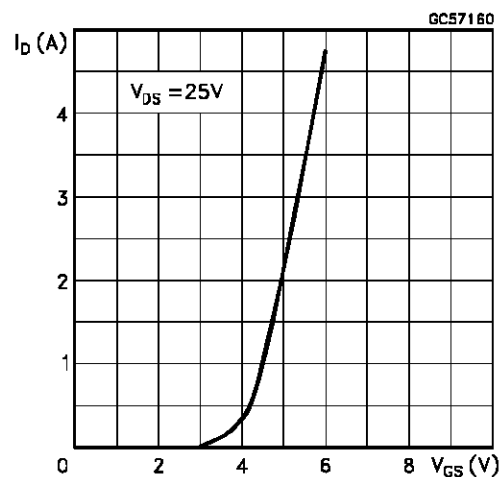

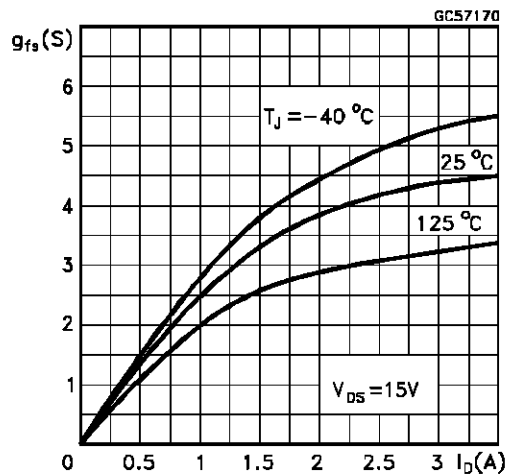

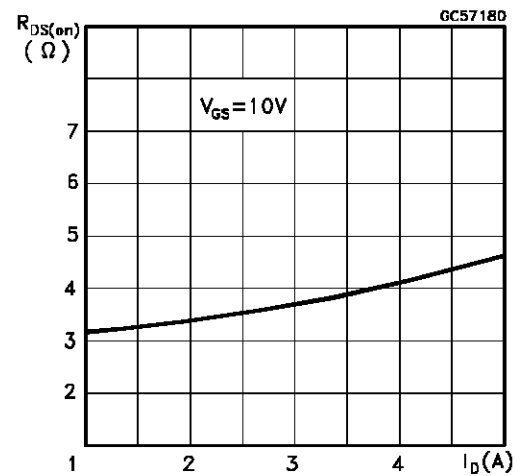

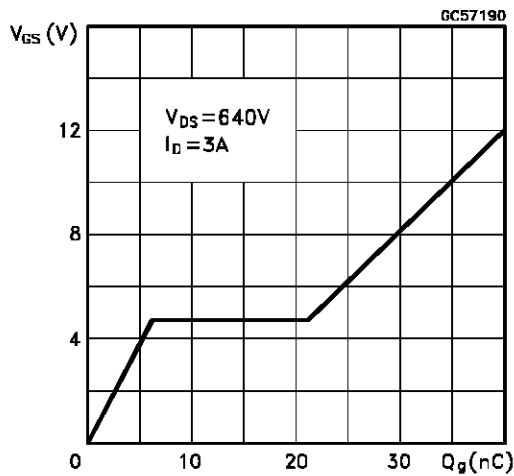

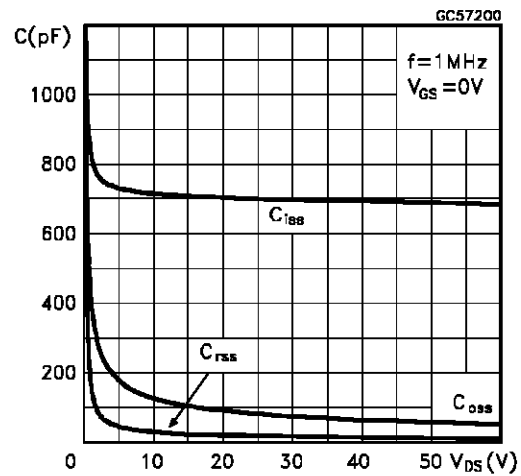
Static Drain-source On Resistance



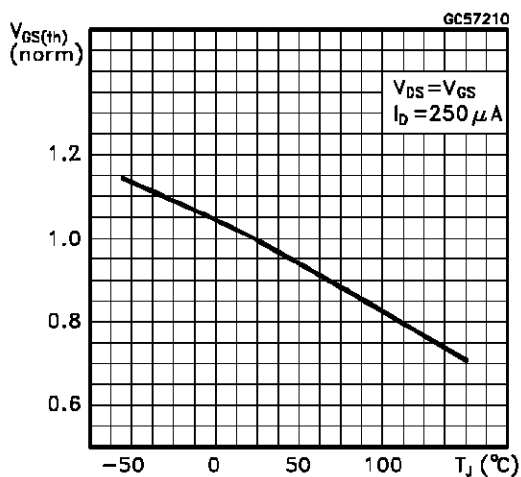
Gate Charge vs Gate-source Voltage



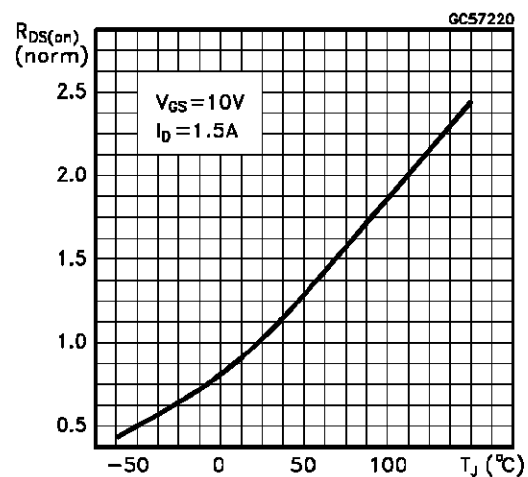
Capacitance Variations



Normalized Gate Threshold Voltage vs Temperature

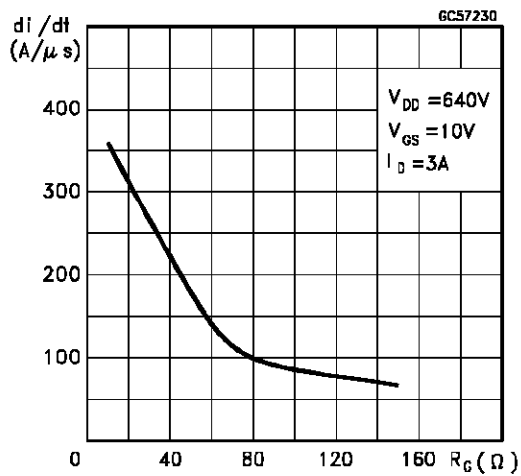


Normalized On Resistance vs Temperature

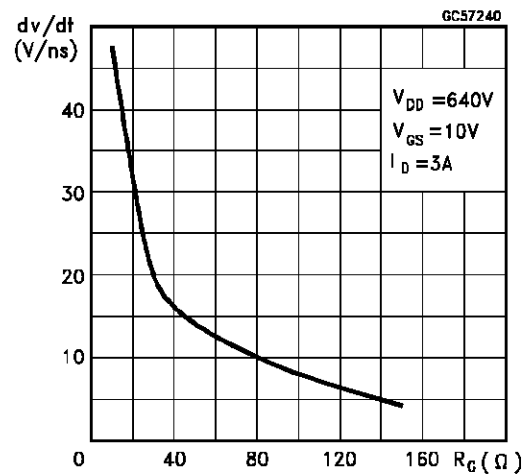


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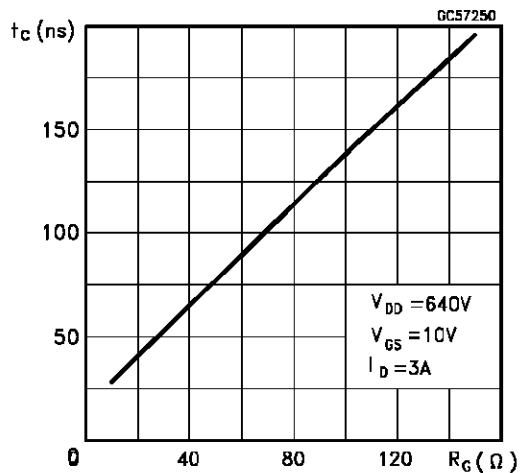
Turn-on Current Slope



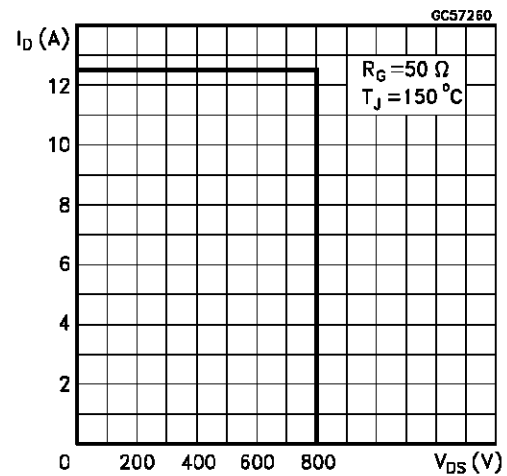
Turn-off Drain-source Voltage Slope



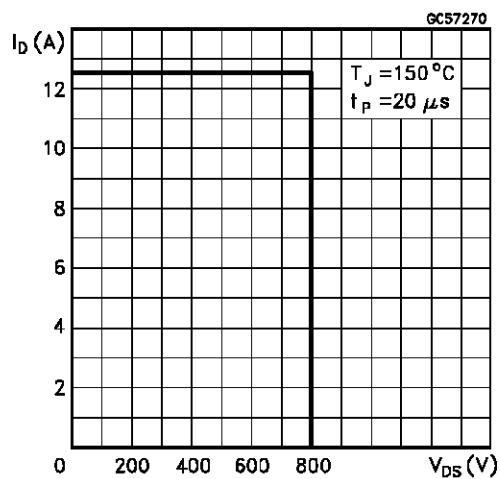
Cross-over Time

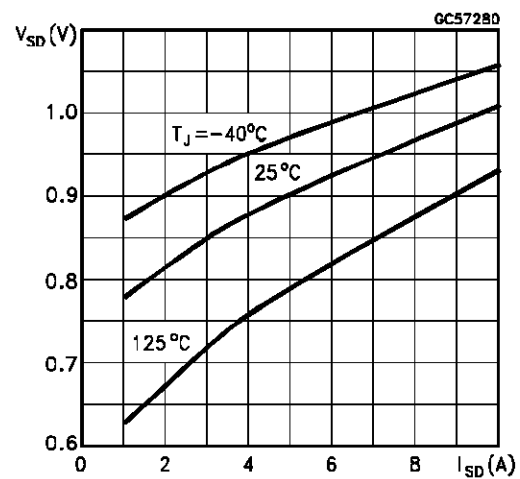
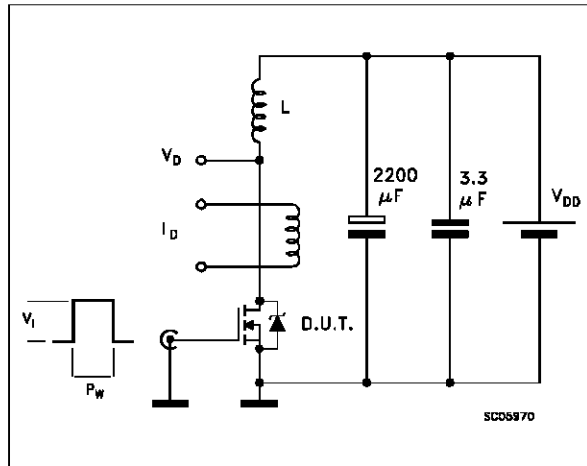
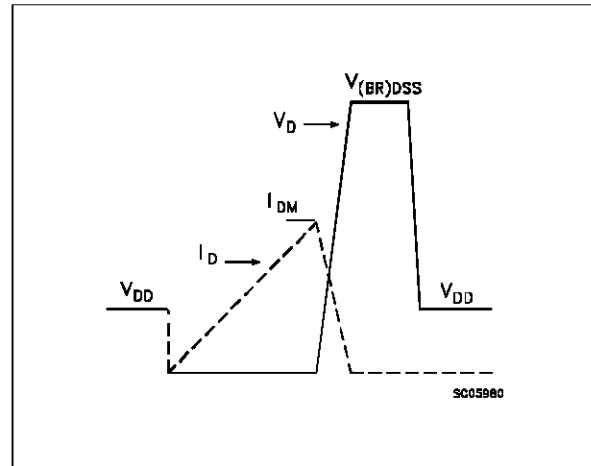
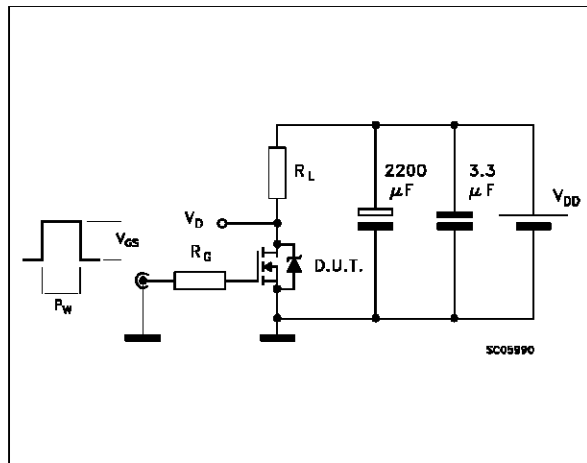
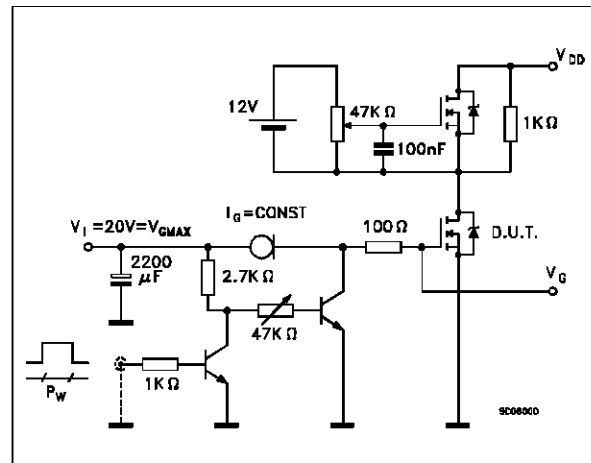
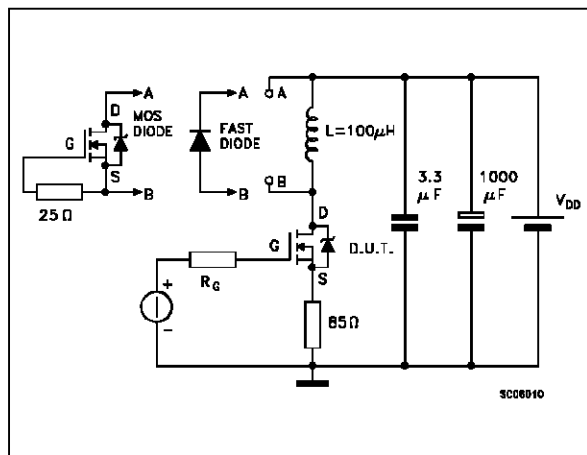
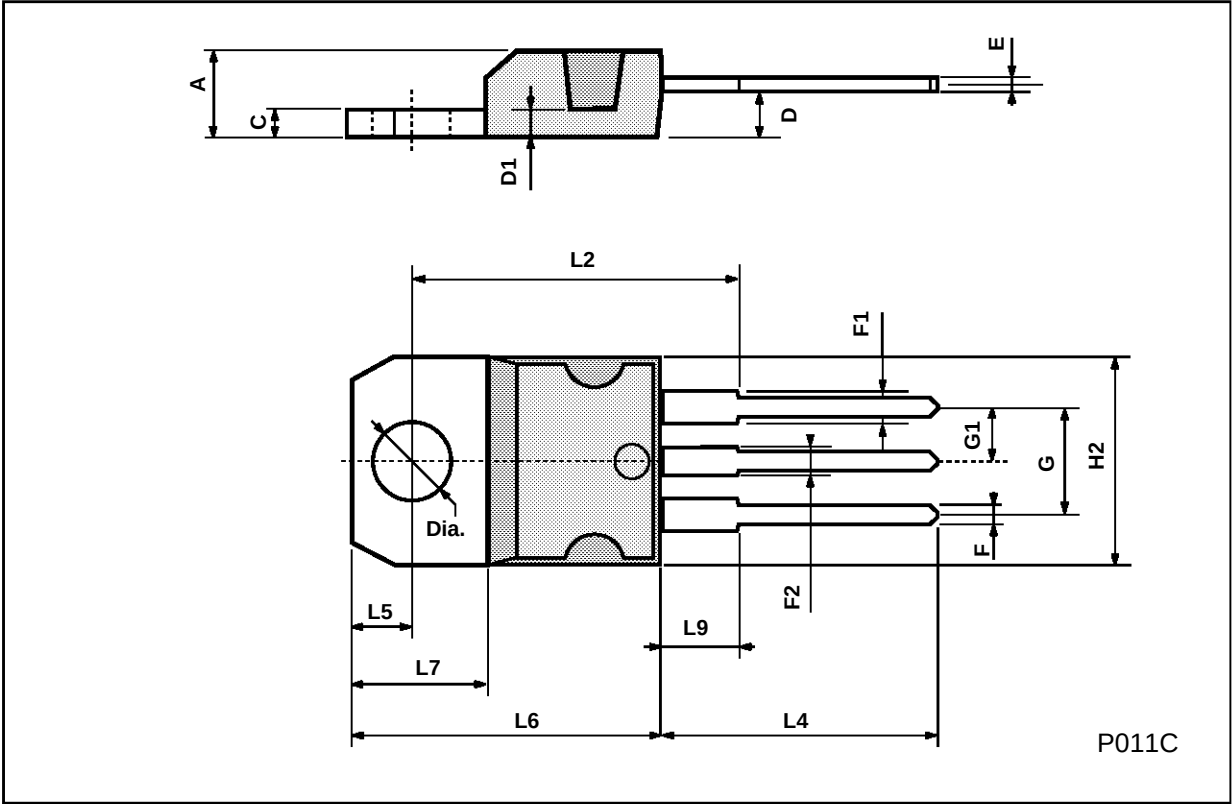


Fig. 1: Unclamped Inductive Load Test Circuits**Fig. 2: Unclamped Inductive Waveforms****Fig. 3: Switching Times Test Circuits For Resistive Load****Fig. 4: Gate Charge Test Circuit****Fig. 5: Test Circuit For Inductive Load Switching And Diode Reverse Recovery Time**

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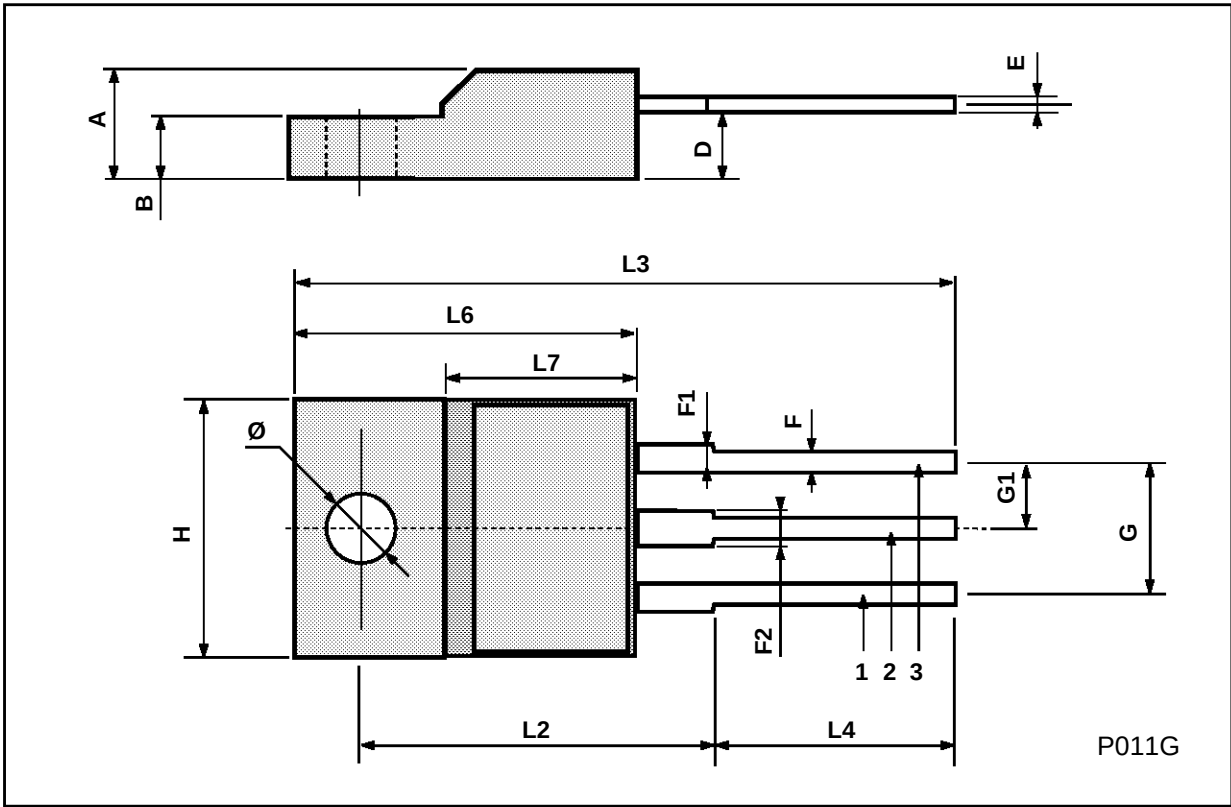
