

FIG. 1 - TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG. 3A - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS




FIG. 4 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE JUNCTION CAPACITANCE, (pF) 400 200 100 80 60 40 20 10 80 .1 .4 40 1.0 10 REVERSE VOLTAGE, (V)

FIG. 3 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS






FIG. 5 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
