# Triple inverting Schmitt trigger Rev. 5 — 7 February 2013

#### 1. **General description**

The XC7WH14 is a high-speed Si-gate CMOS device. This device provides three inverting buffers with Schmitt trigger action. This device is capable of transforming slowly changing input signals into sharply defined, jitter-free output signals.





### 6. Functional diagram










Fig 8. Test circuit for measuring switching times





### 14. Application information

The slow input rise and fall times cause additional power dissipation, which can be calculated using the following formula:

 $P_{add} = f_i \times (t_r \times \Delta I_{CC(AV)} + t_f \times \Delta I_{CC(AV)}) \times V_{CC}$  where:

 $P_{add}$  = additional power dissipation ( $\mu$ W);

 $f_i$  = input frequency (MHz);

 $t_r$  = input rise time (ns); 10 % to 90 %;

 $t_f$  = input fall time (ns); 90 % to 10 %;

 $\Delta I_{CC(AV)}$  = average additional supply current ( $\mu A$ ).




Fig 14. Average additional I<sub>CC</sub>

 $\Delta I_{CC(AV)}$  differs with positive or negative input transitions, as shown in Figure 14.

For XC7WH14 used in relaxation oscillator circuit, see Figure 15.




Fig 16. Package outline SOT505-2 (TSSOP8)



Fig 17. Package outline SOT765-1 (VSSOP8)

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


Fig 18. Package outline SOT833-1 (XSON8)

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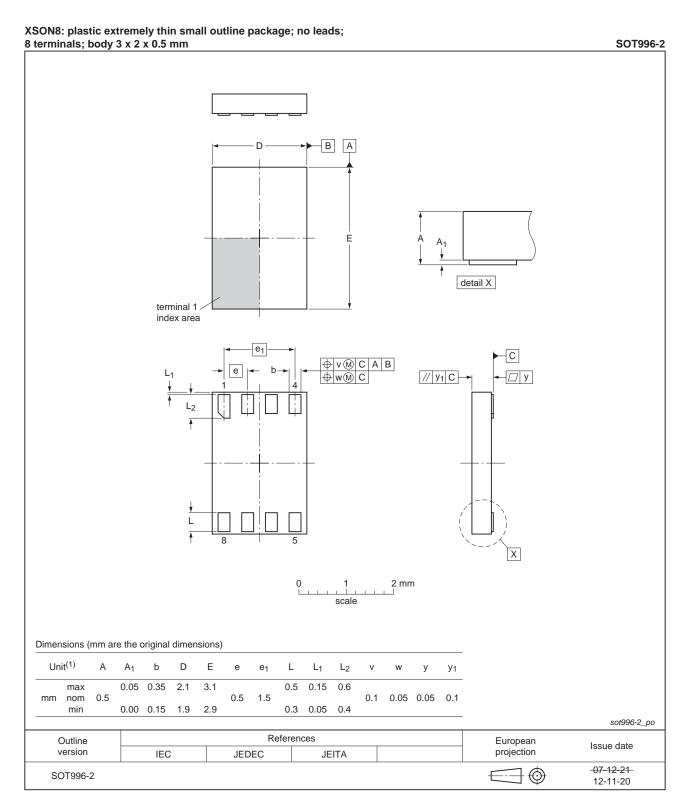


Fig 19. Package outline SOT996-2 (XSON8)
